Matthew 22 (NASB)

37 And He said to him, ““You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ 38 This is the great and foremost commandment. 39 **The second is like it**, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ 40 On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.”

Mateo 22 (NVI)

19 Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, 21 envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

1 Juan 2 (NVI)

¹⁵ No aman al mundo ni nada de lo que hay en él. Si alguien ama al mundo, no tiene el amor del Padre.

¹⁶ Porque nada de lo que hay en el mundo —los malos deseos del cuerpo, la codicia de los ojos y la arrogancia de la vida— proviene del Padre, sino del mundo. ¹⁷ El mundo se acaba con sus malos deseos, pero el que hace la voluntad de Dios permanece para siempre.
