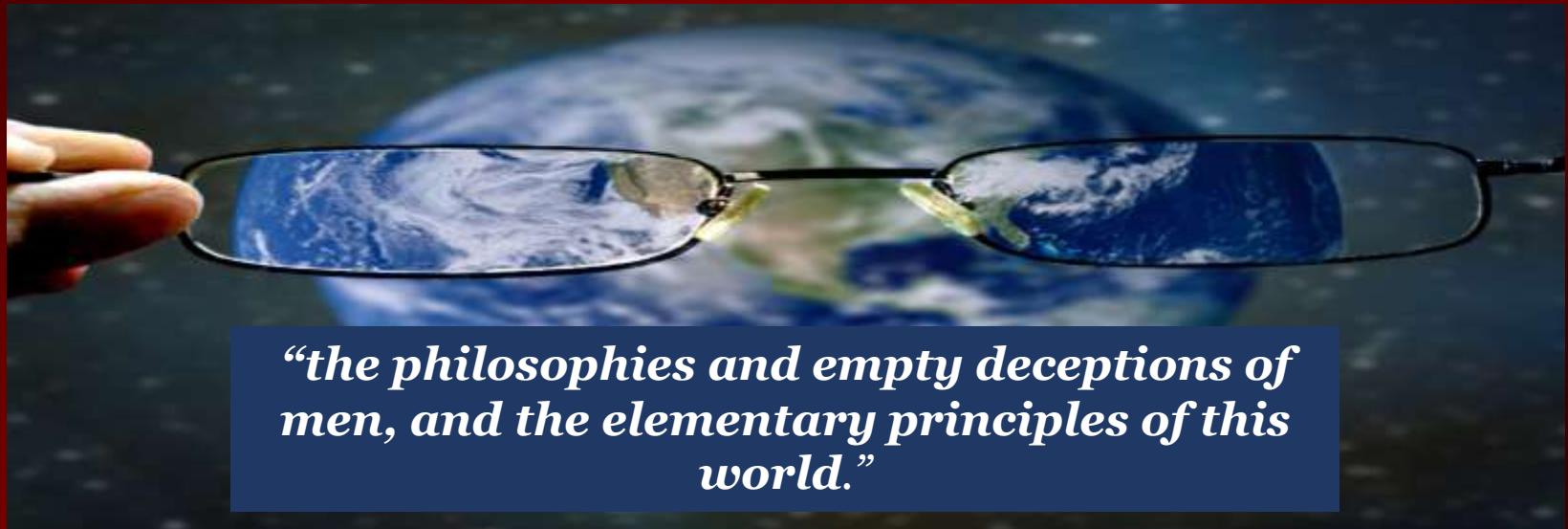

WORLDVIEW FOUNDATIONS

- Objective truth as recorded in the pages of Scripture, revealed in creation, and known in part through the proper usage of human reason and logic – these are the foundations upon which the Christian Worldview is built.

“According to the biblical worldview, people “are children of God, fashioned in His divine image. According to the Social Justice worldview, people are children of society, fashioned by its social constructions and the power of dynamics they maintain.”

WORDS MATTER!

- All cultural change begins with language change.
- **Pro-choice!**
- Fornication, Adultery, Homosexuality...
 - Homosexuality is GAY! Alternate lifestyle. Etc.
 - Adultery / Fornication is having an affair. Shacking up. Hooking up. Etc.

Fornication is the word God uses to describe all sexual behavior that is sinful

- **1 Corinthians 6:9 (NASB)** ⁹ Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals...will inherit the kingdom of God”
 - **1 Corinthians 6:9 (LBLA)**

Colossians 2:8 –

calls them “*hollow and deceptive philosophies.*”

WORDS MATTER

- Take the word in the English and Spanish translations of the Bible for baptism.
- In our English/Spanish Bibles the word for baptism was *not translated*.
- The Greek Word is *baptidzo*. When our English Bibles were produced men dropped the “o” or Omega and added an “e”. Baptidzo became baptize.

Ephesians 4:5 says there is “*one baptism*”

Ephesians 4:5 (LBLA) “*un solo bautismo,*”

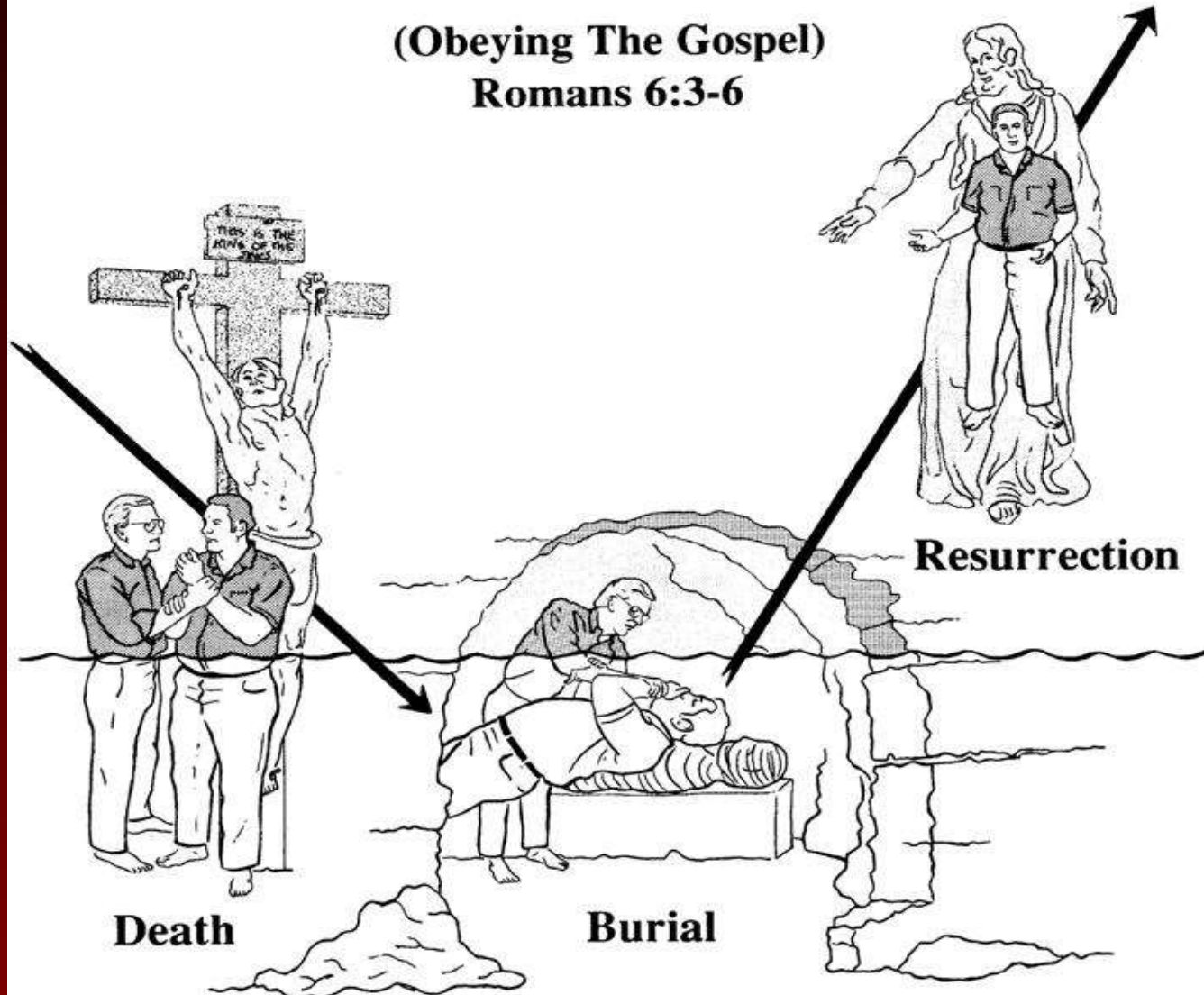

Acts 2:38 (NASB) 38 Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized [*immersed*] in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:38 (LBLA) 38 Y Pedro les dijo: Arrepentíos y sed bautizados (*immersed*) cada uno de vosotros en el nombre de Jesucristo para perdón de vuestros pecados, y recibiréis el don del Espíritu Santo.
