- **Isaiah 9:6-7 (NASB)** 6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

- **John 1:1-3 (NASB)** 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

- Verse 7: *"There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace. On the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore."*



- **Daniel 2:44 (NASB)** 44 "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.

- In Matthew 10:7 - He sent the twelve apostles out preaching the very same message: "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."



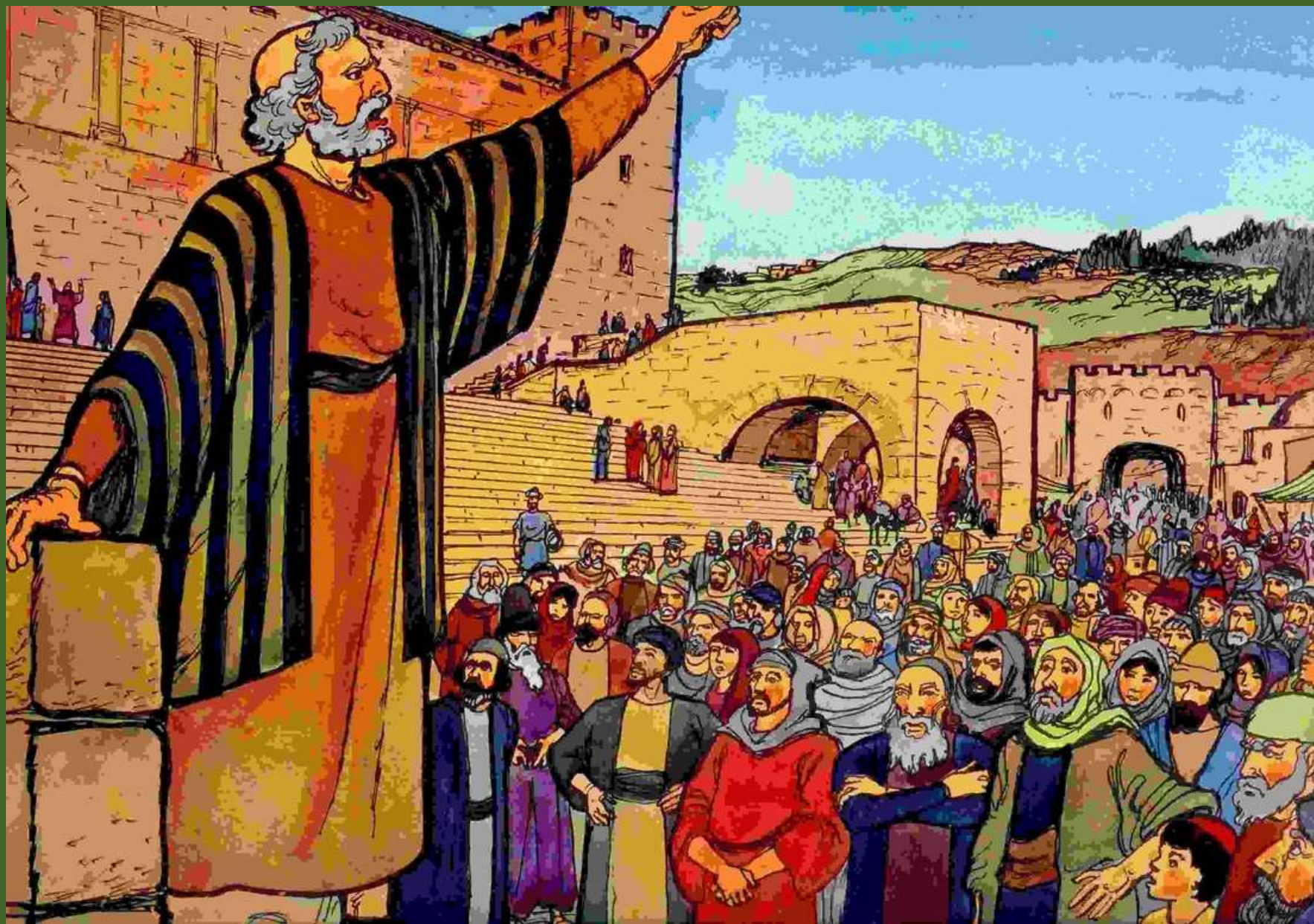


Mark 9:1 – “There are some of those who are standing here who shall not taste death until they see the kingdom of God after it has come with power.”

# HIS NAME

- "Wonderful Counselor."
- The word translated "Counselor" means "one who gives advice or advisor."
- **Romans 10:17** (NASB) 17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

- The peace He brings is for those who accept His rule.
- Luke 2:10-14- *10 And the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy which shall be for all the people; 11 for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. 12 "And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in cloths, and lying in a manger." 13 And suddenly there appeared with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased."*

Romans 2:9-10 - *There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek, 10 but glory and honor and peace to every man who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.*



- Philippians 4:6-7 (NASB) *6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*
