

# *He Who Has Ears to Hear*

- Matthew 11:15 - 15 *"He who has ears to hear, let him hear.*
- Matthew 11:15 (LBLA) — 15 *El que tiene oídos, que oiga.*

Deuteronomy 6:4 KJV *“Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God is one LORD”*.

Deuteronomy 6:4 (LBLA) — 4  
*Escucha, oh Israel, el SEÑOR  
es nuestro Dios, el SEÑOR  
uno es.*

- Nehemiah and his people were commended because they were “*attentive unto the book of the Law*” (Nehemiah 8:3 KJV).
- They taught “*those who could understand.*”
- Proverbs 8:34 “*Happy are those who listen to me*” “*Blessed is the man who listens to me.*” This is the promise that we experience when we hear.
- Proverbs 8:34 (LBLA) — 34  
*Bienaventurado el hombre que me escucha, velando a mis puertas día a día, aguardando en los postes de mi entrada.*

John 10:3–5 MSG.

*“The sheep recognize his voice.... they follow because they are familiar with [the shepherd’s] voice. They won’t follow a stranger’s voice but will scatter because they aren’t used to the sound of it”*

*“He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.” Rev. 2:7, 2:11, 2:17, 2:29, 3:6, 3:13, 3:22.*

Revelation 2:7 (LBLA) — 7 *“El que tiene oído, oiga lo que el Espíritu dice a las iglesias. Al vencedor le daré a comer del árbol de la vida, que está en el paraíso de Dios”».*

- *“Don’t do anything to that man, because he is innocent”* (Matt. 27:19),
- Matthew 27:19 (LBLA) — *19 Y estando él sentado en el tribunal, su mujer le mandó aviso, diciendo: No tengas nada que ver con ese justo, porque hoy he sufrido mucho en sueños por causa de Él.*

- *“Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to me” John 18:37.*
- John 8:37 (LBLA) — **37**  
*Sé que sois descendientes de Abraham; y sin embargo, procuráis matarme porque mi palabra no tiene cabida en vosotros.*

- “Their voices prevailed”  
(Luke 23:23 RSV).



Romans 10:17- Teaches us that  
*“Faith comes from hearing”*

Romans 10:17 (LBLA) — *17 Así  
que la fe viene del oír, y el  
oír, por la palabra de Cristo.*

Mark 1:35 (LBLA) — *35 Levantándose muy de mañana, cuando todavía estaba oscuro, salió, y se fue a un lugar solitario, y allí oraba.*

Luke tells us, “*Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed*” (Luke 5:16 NIV).

Matthew 24:36 (NASB) —

*36 “But of that day and hour  
no one knows, not even the  
angels of heaven, nor the  
Son, but the Father alone.*

- Isaiah 55:8–9 (ESV) — *8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.*
- Isaiah 55:8–9 (LBLA) — *8 Porque mis pensamientos no son vuestros pensamientos, ni vuestros caminos mis caminos—declara el SEÑOR. 9 Porque como los cielos son más altos que la tierra, así mis caminos son más altos que vuestros caminos, y mis pensamientos más que vuestros pensamientos.*

Job 1:22 (ESV) — *22 In all this Job did not sin or charge God with wrong. NASV says, “he did not blame God.”*

Job 1:22 (LBLA) — *22 En todo esto Job no pecó ni culpó a Dios.*
