

You Can Purchase a Piece of Hell

Jesus described hell as a furnace of fire or fiery furnace –

- Matthew 13:41–42 (ESV) — *41 The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will gather out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all law-breakers, 42 and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth*
- Matthew 13:41–42 (LBLA) — *41 El Hijo del Hombre enviará a sus ángeles, y recogerán de su reino a todos los que son piedra de tropiezo y a los que hacen iniquidad; 42 y los echarán en el horno de fuego; allí será el llanto y el crujir de dientes.*

Jesus described Hell as a place of torment

- Luke 16:23 (ESV) — *23 and in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side.*
- Luke 16:23 (LBLA) — *23 En el Hades alzó sus ojos, estando en tormentos, y vio* a Abraham a lo lejos, y a Lázaros en su seno.*

Jesus described hell as everlasting punishment-

- Matthew 25:46 (ESV) — *46 “And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.”*
- Matthew 25:46 (LBLA) — *46 Y estos irán al castigo eterno, pero los justos a la vida eterna.*

Jesus described hell as a place of weeping

- Matthew 8:12 (NASB95) — “*12 but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.*”
- Matthew 8:12 (LBLA) — *12 Pero los hijos del reino serán arrojados a las tinieblas de afuera; allí será el llanto y el crujir de dientes.*

Jesus described hell as a place of weeping and wailing

- Matthew 13:42 (KJV) - *42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.*
- Matthew 13:42 (LBLA) — *42 y los echarán en el horno de fuego; allí será el llanto y el crujir de dientes.*

Jesus describes hell as a place where there will be cries for mercy.

- Luke 16:24 (ESV) — *24 And he called out, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in anguish in this flame.'*
- Luke 16:24 (LBLA) — *24 Y gritando, dijo: «Padre Abraham, ten misericordia de mí, y envía a Lázarro para que moje la punta de su dedo en agua y refresque mi lengua, pues estoy en agonía en esta llama».*

God will not be present in Hell.

- 2 Thessalonians 1:7–9 (NASB 95) — *7 and to give relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, 8 dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power”*
- 2 Thessalonians 1:7–9 (LBLA) — *7 y daros alivio a vosotros que sois afligidos, y también a nosotros, cuando el Señor Jesús sea revelado desde el cielo con sus poderosos ángeles en llama de fuego, 8 dando retribución a los que no conocen a Dios, y a los que no obedecen al evangelio de nuestro Señor Jesús. 9 Estos sufrirán el castigo de eterna destrucción, excluidos de la presencia del Señor y de la gloria de su poder,*

Hell was created for Satan and his angels.

- Matthew 25:41- 41 *"Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; NASU*
- Matthew 25:41 (LBLA) — *41 Entonces dirá también a los de su izquierda: «Apartaos de mí, malditos, al fuego eterno que ha sido preparado para el diablo y sus ángeles.*

Those who follow Satan will spend eternity with him in hell.

- Matthew 25:46 (NASB 95) — *“These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.”*
- Matthew 25:46 (LBLA) — *46 Y estos irán al castigo eterno, pero los justos a la vida eterna.*

According to Jesus Christ Hell is a terrifying place.

- a) It's a place of darkness and weeping and the gnashing of teeth;
- b) a place of consuming worms and undying or unquenchable fire;
- c) a place of “eternal fire”.
- d) The book of Revelation describes the lake of fire as being a place of fire and brimstone, smoke, torment, and no rest.

The Bible contains a stark warning for the lost:

- Revelation 21:8 - *“The cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars— they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.”*
- *Revelation 21:8 (LBLA) — 8 Pero los cobardes, incrédulos, abominables, asesinos, inmorales, hechiceros, idólatras y todos los mentirosos tendrán su herencia en el lago que arde con fuego y azufre, que es la muerte segunda.*

- Revelation 20:10 (NLT) — *10 Then the devil, who had deceived them, was thrown into the fiery lake of burning sulfur, joining the beast and the false prophet. There they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.*
- Revelation 20:10 (LBLA) — *10 Y el diablo que los engañaba fue arrojado al lago de fuego y azufre, donde también están la bestia y el falso profeta; y serán atormentados día y noche por los siglos de los siglos.*

Whoever's name is not written in the Book of Life has much to fear.

- Revelation 20:15 (NASB95) — *15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.*
- Revelation 20:15 (LBLA) — *15 Y el que no se encontraba inscrito en el libro de la vida fue arrojado al lago de fuego.*

A recent Gallup survey found that **86% of Americans believed in Heaven**, and most thought they were going to go there.

But only around 60% of those interviewed believed in Hell.

And just **one-half of 1% of Americans expected to go to Hell when they die.**

Only $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1%???

Heaven Is A Wonderful Place

- “Heaven is a wonderful place, filled with glory and grace, I want to see my Savior’s face, Heaven is a wonderful place. (I want to go there).”
- Then the 2nd verse goes “HELL is a terrible place, filled with sin and pain. I never wanna see that devil’s face, hell is a terrible place (Don’t you go there).”

Hell is also a powerful motivator.

- Richard Dawkins, a well-known atheist, said *“The Fear of Hell is a powerful motivator.”*

IT'S INTERESTING TO NOTE WHO JESUS
OFTEN SPOKE TO ABOUT HELL.

- Matthew 23:33 (NASB95) — **33** *“You serpents, you brood of vipers, how will you escape the sentence of hell?”*
- Matthew 23:33 (LBLA) — **33** *¡Serpientes! ¡Camada de víboras! ¿Cómo escaparéis del juicio del infierno?*

• Matthew 5:29–30 (NASU) — 29 *“If your right eye makes you stumble, tear it out and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. 30 “If your right hand makes you stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to go into hell.*

• Matthew 5:29–30 (LBLA) — 29 *Y si tu ojo derecho te es ocasión de pecar, arráncalo y échalo de ti; porque te es mejor que se pierda uno de tus miembros, y no que todo tu cuerpo sea arrojado al infierno. 30 Y si tu mano derecha te es ocasión de pecar, córtala y échala de ti; porque te es mejor que se pierda uno de tus miembros, y no que todo tu cuerpo vaya al infierno.*

- Galatians 5:19-21 - *“The works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I WARN YOU, AS I WARNED YOU BEFORE, that those who do such things WILL NOT INHERIT THE KINGDOM OF GOD.”*
- Galatians 5:19–21 (LBLA) — *19 Ahora bien, las obras de la carne son evidentes, las cuales son: inmoralidad, impureza, sensualidad, 20 idolatría, hechicería, enemistades, pleitos, celos, enojos, rivalidades, disensiones, sectarismos, 21 envidias, borracheras, orgías y cosas semejantes, contra las cuales os advierto, como ya os lo he dicho antes, que los que practican tales cosas no heredarán el reino de Dios.*

- Romans 3:23 -*All of us have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*
- Ephesians 2:1–3 (NASB) — *1 And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, 2 in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. 3 Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.*
- Colossians 1:21 (NLT) — *21 This includes you who were once far away from God. You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions.*
