- 40 different people wrote the Bible.
 - Over a period of 1500 years.

Nineveh

- Up until Nineveh's archaeological discovery in 1847 by Henry Layard, historians mocked the Bible as historically inaccurate since, except for the Bible, there was no mention of a city called Nineveh from any external sources.

The Hittite Nation.

- The website, Got Questions, shared the following observation: “*The critics reasoned that, since they had no archaeological evidence of a Hittite civilization, it must never have existed, and the Bible must perforce be wrong. However, many archaeological discoveries, beginning in 1876, have since proved that the Hittites were a powerful people in the 15th and 16th centuries B.C.*”

DOES THAT MAKE IT THE

GOD WOULD PROVE IT BY FORETELLING THE FUTURE.

- Isaiah 46:9-10 (NASB-U) "Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, [10] Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, 'My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure'
- Isaiah 46:9–10 (LBLA) — 9 Acordaos de las cosas anteriores ya pasadas, porque yo soy Dios, y no hay otro; yo soy Dios, y no hay ninguno como yo, 10 que declaro el fin desde el principio y desde la antigüedad lo que no ha sido hecho. Yo digo: «Mi propósito será establecido, y todo lo que quiero realizaré».

- Isaiah 46:9-10 - *9 And do not forget the things I have done throughout history. For I am God — I alone! I am God, and there is no one else like me. 10 Only I can tell you what is going to happen even before it happens. Everything I plan will come to pass, for I do whatever I wish.*

- However she also predicted that **WW III would occur in 1954**
- That **Jacqueline Kennedy** would never remarry—(ironically she predicted this the day before she married Aristotle Onassis)
- She predicted the **conflict in Vietnam would end** in 1966 (it continued until 1975)
- We could go on examining all her wrong predictions for some time, but you get the point.
- If you take all her predictions... throw Nostradamus in as well... they were wrong over 90% of the time...

- Deuteronomy 18:21–22 (NASB95) — 21 “You may say in your heart, ‘How will we know the word which the LORD has not spoken?’ 22 “When a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not come about or come true, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken. The prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.
- Deuteronomy 18:21–22 (LBLA) — 21 Y si dices en tu corazón: «¿Cómo conoceremos la palabra que el SEÑOR no ha hablado?». 22 Cuando un profeta hable en el nombre del SEÑOR, si la cosa no acontece ni se cumple, esa es la palabra que el SEÑOR no ha hablado; con presunción la ha hablado el profeta; no tendrás temor de él.

- Genesis 3:15 (NASB95) — 15 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel.”
- Genesis 3:15–16 (LBLA) — 15 Y pondré enemistad entre ti y la mujer, y entre tu simiente y su simiente; él te herirá en la cabeza, y tú lo herirás en el calcañar. 16 A la mujer dijo: En gran manera multiplicaré tu dolor en el parto, con dolor darás a luz los hijos; y con todo, tu deseo será para tu marido, y él tendrá dominio sobre ti.

- Isaiah 7:14- 14 “Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel. NASU
- Isaiah 7:14(LBLA) — 14 Por tanto, el Señor mismo os dará una señal: He aquí, una virgen concebirá y dará a luz un hijo, y le pondrá por nombre Emmanuel.

- So, we know without doubt that these prophesies were in existence a minimum of 300 years before Jesus was born.
- 300 years - three centuries before Christ was born in Bethlehem these prophesies were written, were undeniably in existence, and were available in the Hebrew and Greek Old Testament.

OVER THREE HUNDRED PROPHESIES

- Luke 24:44 (NASB95) — 44 Now He said to them, “These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled.”
- Luke 24:44 (LBLA) — 44 Y les dijo: Esto es lo que yo os decía cuando todavía estaba con vosotros: que era necesario que se cumpliera todo lo que sobre mí está escrito en la ley de Moisés, en los profetas y en los salmos.

- We know that the first Greek Translation of the Bible was written 300 to 250 years before Jesus was born.
- So how could they possibly know that he was going to be born in Bethlehem, and yet hail from Nazareth?
- How could they possibly know that he was going to be crucified, when the prophesies describing his death were written centuries before death by crucifixion was practiced? It didn't exist as a form of Capital punishment?
- How could they know he would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver 250 to 300 years before there was a Jesus?

- Acts 2:22 (NASB95) — 22 “Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know—
- Acts 2:22 (LBLA) — 22 Varones israelitas, escuchad estas palabras: Jesús el Nazareno, varón confirmado por Dios entre vosotros con milagros, prodigios y señales que Dios hizo en medio vuestro a través de Él, tal como vosotros mismos sabéis,

Would we expect him to present to us the greatest teachings mankind ever heard?

- Luke 24:21 (NASB95) — 21 “But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, it is the third day since these things happened.
- Luke 24:21 (LBLA) — 21 Pero nosotros esperábamos que Él era el que iba a redimir a Israel. Pero además de todo esto, este es el tercer día desde que estas cosas acontecieron.

- **John** died a natural death as Jesus had prophesied.
 - **Matthew** was slain with the sword in Ethiopia.
 - **James**, son of Zebedee, was beheaded at Jerusalem.
- **James**, the half-brother of Jesus, was thrown from the pinnacle of the Temple and somehow survived only to be beaten to death with clubs.
 - **Philip** was hanged against a pillar at Hierapolis, in Phrygia.
 - **Bartholomew**, was flayed alive at Albahapolis in Armenia
 - **Andrew** was martyred on a cross at Patre, in Archaia.
- **Thomas** WAS killed with a lance at Coromanded, in East Indies
 - **Thaddeus** was shot to death with arrows.

 - **Matthias** was stoned and then beheaded.
