Isaiah 59

1 Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save, or his ear dull, that it cannot hear;

1 He aquí, no se ha acortado la mano del SEÑOR para salvar; ni se ha endurecido su oído para oír.

2 but your iniquities have made a separation
between you and your God,
and your sins have hidden his face from you
so that he does not hear.

2 Pero vuestras iniquidades han hecho separación
entre vosotros y vuestro Dios,

rostro de vosotros para no escucharos.

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Isaiah 59:3-8

- For your hands are defiled with blood
 - your lips have spoken lies;
 - no one goes to law honestly
 - they conceive mischief and give birth to iniquity

- Porque vuestras manos están manchadas de sangre,
 - vuestros labios hablan mentira,
 - No hay quien clame con justicia ni quien abogue con honestidad
 - conciben malicia, y dan a luz iniquidad

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Isaiah 59:9-15

- Therefore justice is far from us,
 - We all growl like bears;
 - we hope for justice, but there is none
 - he who departs from evil makes himself a prey
-
- Por tanto el derecho está lejos de nosotros,
 - Todos nosotros gruñimos como osos
 - esperamos la justicia^[h], pero no la hay
 - el que se aparta del mal es hecho presa.

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Isaiah 59:16-21

- He saw that there was no man . . . to intercede;
- then **his own arm** brought him salvation

- Vio que no había nadie . . . quien intercediera
- Entonces **su brazo** le trajo salvación

Verse 17

He put on righteousness as a breastplate,
and a helmet of salvation on his head;
he put on garments of vengeance for
clothing, and wrapped himself in zeal as a
cloak.

Se puso la justicia como coraza,
y el yelmo de salvación en su cabeza;
como vestidura se puso ropas de
venganza,
y se envolvió de celo como de un manto.

Eph. 6

- ¹³ Therefore take up the **whole armor of God**, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the **breastplate of righteousness**, ¹⁵ and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; ¹⁷ and take the **helmet of salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God,

Efisios 6
