# Aviate

- Aviate refers to step back and remember to fly the plane

- Romans 12:12 ...Be patient in tribulation...

- John 14:27

# Navigate

- Refers to the pilot gaining their course settings and developing a plan to land at a nearby airport
- Romans 15:4
- For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope

# Communicate

- Refers to the pilot telling the Air Traffic Controller their plan and what issues are happening
- Romans 12:12 ...be constant in prayer...
- Proverbs 27:17
- Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another
